GENERAL

Here and throughout the index, references take the form: month, followed by page or pages. Since the "indexing unit" is a volume beginning in April and ending in March, references to material in issues for "Jan.", "Feb." and "March" follow those for other months.

The bracketed term "(bk.)", "(DVD)" or "(software)" following an entry denotes a review or notice, fuller details of which will be found in the "reviews" section of the index.
